- How would you use digital platforms to amplify governance issues and promote the inclusion of student voices in university administration decisions and policy decisions at national level?

2. Resolving Fundamental National Questions

◆ Group Conflict Resolution & Peacebuilding

- Do you have a project idea that will Foster unity in your immediate community?
- What can you do about communal and inter-tribal conflicts around your choice community?

◆ Gender & Social Inclusion

- Do you have a project idea that will Advocate for inclusive policies on your campus or any other community of your choosing?

◆ Civic Rights Awareness –

- Can your project idea empower your community members to know their rights?
- Can your project provide aid for students facing injustice within and outside the campus.
